The posters and lobby cards in this exhibit depict some of Florida’s most famous films from the early 1920s to the present.

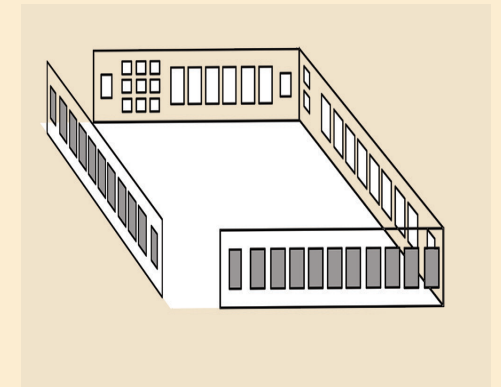
