Thirty-seven panels including title panel, graphic and text panels, photographs, and a credit panel, varying in sizes from 22" x 32" to 49" x 73"; eleven graphic banners varying in size from 36" x 48" to 71" x 95" and a bandstand interactive stage that includes a 4' x 8' checkered tile floor, an 8' x 10' backdrop panel, 2-D cut-out band figures, 2-D cut-out instruments, and a 2-D cut-out vintage juke box. Also includes a 10 minute blues documentary digital video file in the promo pack.
